

Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2014

THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**.

2. In these regulations —

“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.

3. The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 3 and replacing it by the following regulation —

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall export any controlled goods, unless he holds an export permit.

(2) No export permit shall be required in respect of a sample of controlled goods bearing H.S. Code 10.06, 11.01, 17.01 or 25.23 where —

(a) it is being exported for the purpose of analysis and marketing only;

(b) it weighs 10 kilogrammes or less; and

(c) no transfer of funds is involved.

4. These regulations shall come into operation on 15 March 2014.
