## THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Export Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.
- In these regulations —
  "principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Export Control) Regulations 2000.
- **3.** The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 3 and replacing it by the following regulation
  - **3.** (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall export any controlled goods, unless he holds an export permit.
  - (2) No export permit shall be required in respect of a sample of controlled goods bearing H.S. Code 10.06, 11.01, 17.01 or 25.23 where
    - (a) it is being exported for the purpose of analysis and marketing only;
    - (b) it weighs 10 kilogrammes or less; and
    - (c) no transfer of funds is involved.
- 4. These regulations shall come into operation on 15 March 2014.
