#### THE JEWELLERY ACT 2007

# Regulations made by the Minister under Section 31 of the Jewellery Act 2007

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Jewellery (**Registration of Sponsor's mark, Importer's mark, Identification mark**) Regulations 2008.
- 2. In these regulations:-
  - "Act" means the Jewellery Act 2007;
  - "mark" means a sponsor's mark, an importer's mark or an identification mark.
- 3. (1) A person who wishes to register a sponsor's mark, an importer's mark or an identification mark shall make an application to the Director for registration of that mark.
  - (2) A person shall not make an application under paragraph (1) unless he is a dealer registered with the Director under section 15 of the Act.
- 4. A person who wishes to display or offer for sale jewellery which has been marked with an identification mark of the manufacturer shall register that identification mark with the Director.
- 5. A registered dealer who makes an application under regulation 3 shall-
  - (a) fill an application form as set out in the First Schedule; and
  - (b) pay a fee of 3,000\* rupees for the registration of the mark.
- 6. The Director may, on receipt of an application under regulation 3, refuse to register a mark if-
  - (a) the impression of the sponsor's mark or importer's mark as specified under section 10(4) and section 11(4) of the Act is distorted or not legible; or
  - (b) the facsimile of an identification mark is not legible or does not reveal a true likeness of the mark.
- 7 The Director shall, where he is satisfied that a mark may be registered, grant to the applicant a certificate of registration as set out in the Second Schedule.
- 8. A dealer, to whom a certificate of registration has been granted, shall display the certificate in a conspicuous place on his business premises.
- 9. Where a dealer has ceased business or where his registration as dealer has been suspended, cancelled or has not been renewed, the Director shall cancel the registration of any mark allocated to that dealer.

- 10. (1) A dealer may apply for a new certificate of registration if-
  - (a) he loses his certificate of registration; or
  - (b) he requires an additional certificate of registration.
  - (2) Where a new certificate is issued under paragraph (1), the dealer shall pay a fee of 500 rupees\*.
- 11. These regulations shall come into operation on 9 May 2008.
