THE FOREST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2015

Citation G.N. No 153 of 2004 1. These regulations may be cited as Forest (amendment) Regulations, 2015 and shall be read as one with the Forest Regulation, 2004 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

Amendment of the Schedules

2.-(1) The Eighth and Fourteenth Schedules to the principal Regulations are hereby revoked and substituted for them Schedules specified in these Regulations.

(2) The scale of fees specified in the Eighth Schedule shall come into operation on the 21^{st} day of August, 2015
